LAS VEGAS - Last night, American-Indie pop singer, Conan Gray, booked a sold-out show of 2,000 concertgoers at the Brooklyn Bowl Las Vegas, highlighting his fourth tour in his musical career. The show-stopping concert highlights the singer's hit singles such as "Memories" "Telepathy" and "Overdrive" from his latest album "Superache." Before the performance started, the venue overflowed with supporters as many were standing outside the box office for hours. "When I first got here, I was wondering why we were playing in a bowling alley. I imagine singing a sad song and someone goes strike," said Gray. More than 2,000 fans were engrossed in such emotional performances with tears shed and screaming lyrics resounding the entire venue. The concert garnered success at the bowling venue concert, jam-packed with ardent followers and stunning visuals. Throughout his performance, many Coneheads, his self-proclaimed fandom, had intimate moments with the singer as he sang of heartache from love and childhood. "I truly felt connected with Conan's lyrics, I even teared up when he was telling his stories before he even started singing," a fan exclaimed.

Following his "Kid Krow" album, Gray's sophomore album debuted on June 24, 2022. The second album ranked at number nine for 12 weeks on Billboard 200.
